The Government of Uganda (GoU) received credit from the International Development Association (IDA) towards Additional Financing (AF) of the Competitive and Enterprise Development Project (CEDP-AF) in order to scale up the successful outcomes, with the aim of deepening both the sustainability and impact of the operation.

The Project Development Objective is to increase private sector investment in Tourism Sector and strengthen access to and effectiveness of the Land Administration System. The AF is intended to complete the implementation of the Land and Tourism components while consolidating and enhancing the achievements realised as well as scaling up activities under these components.

In compliance with the World Bank Environmental and Social Safeguards Policies and Public Disclosure requirements, GoU through the Private Sector Foundation Uganda (PSFU) and the CEDP prepared and disclosed the Environmental and Social Management Framework for CEDP-AF which has now been revised and enhanced.

The CEDP-AF commenced in the Financial Year 2020/2021 and is expected to close in the Financial Year 2024/2025.
